Innovation continues to shape how we care for our patients. With our breast AI software supporting our radiologists and the addition of the upgraded MRI, we are reducing scan times while enhancing image quality, improving the experience and outcomes for our patients.

Our signature Mammograms Save Lives luncheon brought people together to raise money for funding breast exams for underserved women in our community who cannot afford them. This event alone raised over \$147,000 to provide financial aid for hundreds of patients in need. Beyond the event, our outreach programs, including FaithHealth in Action, expanded this year to reaching more than 11,000 community members with education, resources, and guidance on breast health.

The true measure of our work is the gratitude we see from patients. Every appointment, every exam, every conversation matters. The dedication of our staff, volunteers, and Board of Directors ensures that every person who walks through our doors feels cared for. Together, we are making a difference every single day.

Adriene Tillman and Debra Thomas are breast health navigators for the Carol Milgard Breast Center through our partnership with Leaders in Women's Health. As navigators, they connect women in the community directly to our screening mammogram events, providing support, answering questions, easing nerves, and celebrating each appointment as a step toward better health. Their work focuses on women who are uninsured, underinsured, or medically underserved, ensuring that everyone has access to the breast health services they need.

In 2024, Adriene and Debra personally guided 57 patients to the Carol Milgard Breast Center for screening mammograms.

Their commitment to community health and patient care was celebrated when they threw the first pitches at the 2024 Pink at the Park event with the Tacoma Rainiers. The crowd cheered, just as they cheer for the women they serve every day...a fun and fitting moment that recognized their work, the power of community, and the importance of early detection.

Adriene and Debra's efforts illustrate the goal of the Carol Milgard Breast Center: saving lives through early detection and showing every woman that she is supported, empowered, and cared for.

As a nonprofit, the Carol Milgard Breast Center reinvests earnings back into local communities to support and fund a variety of breast health programs and services.
